

Coming by car?

A127 Southend bound: leave the A127 at the Basildon/Billericay turnoff. At the roundabout take the 1st exit, go under the bridge and at the next roundabout take the 1st exit, the Campanile Hotel will be on your left, and Asda will be on your right. At the traffic lights go right and follow the road down, when approaching the traffic lights turn left into Crompton Close. Follow the road round and we are on your left just past Prospects College (blue and yellow building).

A127 London bound: leave the A127 at the Basildon/Billericay turnoff. At the roundabout take the 2nd exit (straight over), the Campanile Hotel will be on your left, and Asda will be on your right. At traffic lights follow directions as above.

A13 Southend bound: take the Basildon turnoff (signposted for Hospital & Festival Leisure Park). At hospital roundabout keep in middle lane and head towards town centre. At BP Garage roundabout take the 2nd exit and follow signs for Festival Leisure. Go left at next roundabout, take 3rd exit at following roundabout. Go left at the traffic lights and take the first right into Crompton Close. Follow the road round and we are on your left just past Prospects College.

Parking

We suggest you park either in the road outside the centre, or in our car park. If you do park in the road please ensure you are not obstructing any of the entrances to the businesses as traffic wardens often patrol the road.

Coming by train?

Basildon train station is situated in Station Way, and is on the c2c line; trains run from Shoeburyness quite regularly. We do not recommend you walk to the centre from here, as it is a very long walk. For timetables visit www.c2c-online.co.uk. There is a taxi rank situated at the back of the train station; there are often taxi's waiting there, if you do not see one you can call Taxi Call on 01268 858585.

Coming by bus?

Basildon bus station is situated in Southernhay, and is just across the road from Basildon train station. There are a number of different service numbers to travel on, using both Arriva and First Bus operators. If you are travelling from Chelmsford then you need to get the number 100 service, this runs quite frequently, and you need to get off at the Pipp's Hill Retail Park (Asda), Miles Gray Road, this is roughly a 15 minute walk from the centre. If you are getting the bus from Basildon town centre you will also need to get the number 100 service. For timetables visit www.firstgroup.com
